



“Family Time” Road Trip Itinerary

Get ready for a packed schedule from start to finish that the whole family will enjoy.

Story Land (Glen) Start the morning at this storybook theme park and discover over 30 family attractions including Alice’s Tea Cups and the Roar-O-Saurus roller coaster. Open Memorial Day through October, purchase tickets in advance at StoryLandNH.com.

Cheese Louise (North Conway) Switch gears midday and stop into Settlers Green for a quick bite at Cheese Louise, serving up gourmet grilled cheese and fresh squeezed lemonade. Open seasonally; See settlersgreen.com/eat for hours.

Mt. Washington Valley Rec Path (North Conway) The beautifully winding 2.9-mile Rec Path runs from Cranmore Mountain Resort south to Hemlock Lane, which is located just south of Settlers Green off of North-South Road. It is open to all non-motorized vehicles (other than Class 1 E-Bikes). From Settlers Green, exit from Common Court to North-South Road. Head south (right at the first roundabout) onto North-South Road from Common Court. Go straight at the second roundabout then left at the third roundabout onto Hemlock Lane. Parking is located at the end.

Ryan’s (North Conway) Return from the Rec Path and head over to Ryan’s! Ryan’s has over 50 arcade games including video, skill and virtual reality games. It also has a 5,000 square foot AirPark – it’s like a bounce house the size of the building! Restaurant and bar will make this the perfect spot to feed the kids and have a blast!
