



“Kid-Free Weekend” Road Trip Itinerary

Take it slow and make it adventurous on your day away from the kids.

The Met Coffeehouse (North Conway) Kick off the day with some freshly brewed coffee and pastries from The Met, with two convenient locations in North Conway at Settlers Green and in North Conway Village. Both locations feature local art.

Settlers Green Art Walk (North Conway) Stroll with your coffee in tow to over fifteen art features around Settlers Green including murals and sculptures created by local and regional artists. More at settlersgreen.com/public-art.

Cranmore Mountain Resort (North Conway) Test your adventurous limits at Cranmore Mountain Resort, offering beginning downhill mountain biking for all ages. Cranmore has a scenic chairlift ride to the summit for a more casual experience along with lunch and beverage options at its famed Meister Hut. Open Memorial Day through Columbus Day, purchase tickets in advance at cranmore.com.

Cathedral Ledge (North Conway) Pack a lunch and drive to the top of Cathedral Ledge, part of Echo Lake State Park. Cathedral Ledge looks out over the Mt. Washington Valley with a direct view of the trails at Cranmore. Learn more about reservations and park fees at nhstateparks.org.

The SoakingPot Infusion Spa (North Conway) End the day with a moment of relaxation at The SoakingPot, with foot soaks starting at \$26. The SoakingPot also has a full retail shop with unique gifts, bath and body products and teas. Appointments must be made in advance at thesoakingpot.com.

Barley & Salt Tap House and Kitchen (North Conway) If you’re a fan of beer, Barley & Salt is the place in town to try the best local and regional brews, with over 30 drafts available. For local brews, ask the bartender what’s on tap from Tuckerman Brewing., Moat Mountain Brewing or Saco River Brewing. Open Daily; Menu at barleyandsalt.com.
