International Mountain Climbing School (North Conway) Offering a variety of climbing adventure and safety training courses, the IMCS is a great way to get into the wild with a guide and support. Ellis River (Jackson) After discovering adventures in the White Mountain National Forest, keep an eye out along Route 16 north of Jackson Village for quick spots to dip your toes into the chilly, but peaceful Ellis River. If your legs are up for it, visit Glen Ellis Falls. Descend a series of wooden staircases into a ravine to view this incredible waterfall. See www.fs.usda.gov/whitemountain for more information.

Black Cap Grille (North Conway) Before heading out of town, cap off your day with a great meal and award-winning cocktail at Black Cap Grille, located in Settlers Crossing next to REI Co-Op.
